A resolution waiving the use fee for the Slidell City Auditorium to the St. Tammany Sheriff Deputies Association, Inc.

WHEREAS, the employees of the St. Tammany Parish Sheriff's Office are planning a fund-raising talent show and dance to be held on April 4, 1987 in an effort to offset some of the costs associated with conducting such a campaign; and

WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Sheriff Deputies Association, Inc. has humbly asked the City's help and support for their cause by allowing them to hold their talent show and dance in the Slidell City Auditorium, and at the same time waive the use fee for the building; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that fees for the use of the Slidell City Auditorium are hereby waived for the St. Tammany Deputies Association, Inc. for April 4, 1987.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the St. Tammany Deputies Association, Inc. shall pay to the City of Slidell a damage deposit in the amount of one hundred seventy-five dollars (\$175.00) which shall be refunded them by the City following the April 4, 1987 event provided no damages occur to the Slidell City Auditorium as a result of said event.
