## RESOLUTION R87-18

A resolution urging the House Committee on Appropriations to retain full funding for the Tobacco Tax Fund.

WHEREAS, House Bill 325 by Representative Raymond Laborde calls for full funding of the Tobacco Tax Fund for distribution to towns and cities in the next fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, it has become apparent that State Legislators might be forced to consider reducing or possibly eliminating those funds to towns and cities during the appropriation-cutting process as was the case last year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has already suffered from the forty percent cut in Tobacco Tax Fund allocations last year, and cannot afford to lose any further State funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City

Council hereby urges the House Committee on Appropriations and our

area Legislators to reinstate full funding of the Tobacco Tax Fund

for distribution to towns and cities in this next fiscal year.
