A resolution amending the Suncrest Subdivision Planned Development by eliminating the jogging path and by allowing fencing of the common area of said jogging path.

WHEREAS, Accent Homes, the developer of Suncrest
Planned Unit Development (PUD) has proposed an amendment to the
said PUD, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Suncrest Subdivision Home Owners Association, Inc. has passed a resolution in support of said amendment, and

WHEREAS, the residents of Suncrest Subdivision have signed a petition requesting said amendment, and

WHEREAS, said amendment was approved by the Slidell Planning and Zoning Commission.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council does hereby approve the amendment of Accent Homes to eliminate the jogging path within the Suncrest Planned Development and allow said residents to fence their portion of the common area within said jogging path.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all improvements scheduled for completion in Phase I, fitness stations, kiosk, and tot lot, shall be completed by January 1, 1988 or before any building permits are issued for Phase II of Suncrest, whichever comes first. All improvements to be completed in Phase II shall be completed at th time 50% of the lots have been developed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a garage will be constructed with each residential unit and shall have the same design scheme as the residential structures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that one tree shall be planted in the street parkway area per platted lot. Each tree shall have a minimum planting caliper of three (3) inches as measured 24 inches above the ball of the tree. Species of trees planted shall be approved by the Planning Department.

structures shall conform with the accessory structure setbacks prescribed under Section 10.4 of the Zoning Ordinance. Where lot lines do not exist, the limits of the exclusive common area right shall be designated as a lot line for purposes of defining setback.
