RESOLUTION R87-36

A resolution authorizing St. Tammany Parish to participate in a regional transportation planning process with the Regional Planning Commission.

WHEREAS, the Parish of St. Tammany is a member of the Regional Planning Commission for Jefferson, Orleans, St. Bernard, and St. Tammany Parishes; and

WHEREAS, the Regional Planning Commission coordinates all major transportation planning efforts and projects with the regional transportation plan developed by the Regional Planning Commission (RPC), in accordance with federal guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the current regional transportation plan initially was developed by the RPC roughly ten years ago; and

WHEREAS, the said plan is in need of revisions and/or updates to reflect more accurately the impact of current and projected major land use changes; and

WHEREAS, directors of the planning agencies in the Parishes of Jefferson, Orleans, St. Bernard, and St. Tammany Parish, and the director of the RPC, now propose with the concurrence of the affected local governing bodies at no cost, to attempt to develop a work scope for the investigation and analysis necessary to adequately revise and/or update the existing regional transportation plan, including matters pertaining to cost and sources of funds; and

WHEREAS, upon completion of said technical work scope the findings shall be presented to all affected local governing bodies for a determination of subsequent action that may be declared to be necessary or desirable.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Slidell City
Council that they do hereby endorse the proposal set forth above
to document, at no cost, those tasks necessary to revise and

update the existing regional transportation plan including cost estimates and potential sources of funds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the local planning agencies involved in the effort, and the RPC report to the Slidell City Council on their findings in order that a determination of subsequent necessary actions can be made.
