## **RESOLUTION R87-46**

A resolution suspending the operation and enforcement of Section 9-79 Unnecessary Noise Subsection (C) Prohibitions 1. Maximum Permissible Sound Levels of Chapter 9. Crimes - Miscellaneous\* of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell, and in the interim the provisions of Section 2.1901 of Appendix A-Zoning shall be adhered.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council on August 25, 1987, introduced a revision to Chapter 9 Criminal Code Crimes - Miscellaneous\* of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on said revision on September 22, 1987; and

WHEREAS, no one from the public opposed the proposed amendments; and

WHEREAS, said revised Criminal Code contained a revision to Section 9-79 Unnecessary Noise; and

WHEREAS, said revision measured the noise level in decibels; and

WHEREAS, the decibel levels were established in accordance with other municipalities; and

WHEREAS, there is now some concerns as to the established decibel level.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council hereby suspends the operation and enforcement of Section 9-79 Unnecessary Noise of Chapter 9. Crimes - Miscellaneous\* of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell for forty-five (45) days.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Section 2.1901 of Appendix A-Zoning shall be adhered during the suspension of operation and enforcement of the said forty-five (45) day period.
