17 A resolution suspending the operation and enforcement of  
18 Section 9-79 Unnecessary Noise Subsection (C) Prohibitions 1.  
19 Maximum Permissible Sound Levels of Chapter 9. Crimes -  
20 Miscellaneous\* of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell,  
21 and in the interim the provisions of Section 2.1901 of Appendix  
22 A-Zoning shall be adhered.

24 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council on August 25, 1987,  
25 introduced a revision to Chapter 9 Criminal Code Crimes -  
26 Miscellaneous\* of the Code of Ordinances of the City of  
27 Slidell; and

29 WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on said revision on  
30 September 22, 1987; and  
31

32 WHEREAS, no one from the public opposed the proposed  
33 amendments; and  
34

35 WHEREAS, said revised Criminal Code contained a revision  
36 to Section 9-79 Unnecessary Noise; and  
37

38 WHEREAS, said revision measured the noise level in  
39 decibels; and  
40

41 WHEREAS, the decibel levels were established in  
42 accordance with other municipalities; and  
43

44 WHEREAS, there is now some concerns as to the  
45 established decibel level.  
46

47 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City  
48 Council hereby suspends the operation and enforcement of Section  
49 9-79 Unnecessary Noise of Chapter 9. Crimes - Miscellaneous\* of  
50 the Code of Ordinances of the City of Slidell for forty-five (45)  
51 days.  
52

53 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Section 2.1901 of Appendix  
54 A-Zoning shall be adhered during the suspension of operation and  
55 enforcement of the said forty-five (45) day period.
