## **RESOLUTION R88-10**

A resolution identifying Capital Projects for the City of Slidell and establishing a policy for interest thereon.

Resolution R88-10 is hereby rescinded and reenacted as follows:

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has sold \$5,000,000 in public improvement bonds as Bond Issue #1; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has authorized the sale of \$5,000,000 in public improvement bonds as Bond Issue #2; and

WHEREAS, interest is earned through the investment of Capital Project funds prior to their expenditure; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council desires to identify all Capital Projects covered by the specific bond issues; and

WHEREAS, the public improvements to be constructed from the sale of the bonds are identified on the attached schedule and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Capital Projects funded by Bond Issue #1 are hereby restated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that the enumerated projects for public improvements from the sale of Bond Issue #2 are hereby authorized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the intention of the Slidell City Council to dedicate any interest income earned by the investment of the proceeds from Bond Issue #1 and #2 to a special Reserve Fund to be used in the Capital Project Program of the City of Slidell.
