## RESOLUTION R88-15

A resolution waiving the permit fee for the removal of trees damaged by tornados on Saturday, April 2, 1988, in the City of Slidell, which have lost their esthetic value.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell was hit by a fierce tornado or tornados on Saturday, April 2, 1988; and

WHEREAS, said tornado or tornados did severe damage to area property and trees; and

WHEREAS, as a result of a tornado or tornados many trees were uprooted or damaged and now pose a public hazard; and

WHEREAS, other trees have lost their esthetic value; and WHEREAS, the City of Slidell requires a permit fee for the removal of certain trees and/or quantity of trees; and

WHEREAS, permits are required, but permit fees are waived for any tree removals which pose a threat to life and property.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Slidell City Council does hereby waive any and all permit fees for the removal of trees which have lost their esthetic value as a result of any tornado damage for a period of sixty (60) days.
