RESOLUTION R88-37

A resolution directed to the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development requesting that the north lane of Gause Boulevard going west, at its intersection with U.S. Highway 11, be designated as a right turn only lane.

WHEREAS, the intersection of U.S. Highway 11 and Gause Boulevard is a very busy intersection; and

WHEREAS, Gause Boulevard serves as a primary traffic artery to the City of Slidell; and

whereas, the north lane of Gause Boulevard going west ends at its intersection with U.S. Highway 11, requires motorist to merge into the southbound lane when crossing the railroad tracks; and

WHEREAS, this is a very dangerous situation which causes major traffic congestion.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, in legal session convened, that the Louisiana Department of Transportation is requested to designate the north lane of Gause Boulevard heading west, at its intersection with U.S. Highway 11, as a right turn only lane.
