## **RESOLUTION R88-39**

A resolution requesting that the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development to install a traffic control sign on U.S. Highway 11, and also requesting the City of Slidell to install traffic control devices within the Belvedere Subdivision and the Albertson's development.

WHEREAS, the proposed Albertson's development is scheduled for construction in the area of U.S. Highway 11 and Lafayette Street; and

WHEREAS, traffic problems are anticipated in this area; and

WHEREAS, additional traffic control devices and signs will be required; and

WHEREAS, a traffic control island on the Albertson's development is proposed that will prohibit through traffic on Lafayette Street east or west bound crossing U.S. Highway 11.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City

Council does hereby request the Louisiana Department of

Transportation and Development to install a "No Left Turn" sign

south bound at the intersection of U.S. Highway 11 and Lafayette

Street.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council requests the following additional traffic control measures:

- Lafayette Street shall be one (1) way traffic only going east from Front Street.
- 2. Place a "Do Not Enter" sign on Lafayette Street at its intersection with Dale Street.
- 3. Provide a three (3) way "Stop" sign at the intersection of 7th and Dale Streets.
- 4. Retain the "No Right Turn" sign at the intersection of Lafayette and Dale Streets.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Albertson's development shall contain a traffic control island which shall prohibit through traffic on Lafayette Street east or west bound crossing U.S. Highway 11.
