## RESOLUTION R88-42

A resolution authorizing the submission of an application for low-rent housing.

WHEREAS, the United States Housing Act of 1937 provides that there shall be local determination of the need for low-rent housing to meet needs not being adequately met by private enterprises; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the United States
Housing Act of 1937, the Secretary of Housing and Urban
Development is authorized to provide financial assistance to
public housing agencies for low-rent housing; and

WHEREAS, it is the findings of the City Council of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, that there exists definite needs as follows:

- Due to the economic conditions at present, their exists a large number of families on the Housing Authority's Waiting List who needs rental assistance.
- There are families who are living in rental properties that are substandard.
- 3. There exist several blighted areas within the City.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that there is a need for additional low-income housing for the City of Slidell.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council in regular session convened, that the Housing Authority of the City of Slidell, Louisiana, is hereby authorized to submit two (2) original low-rent housing project applications, in accordance with the United States Housing Act of 1937.
