15 A resolution suspending the provisions of Appendix  
16 A-Zoning Section 2.902 to allow for a trailer at the Central  
17 Fire Station's temporary location on Fremaux Avenue.

19 WHEREAS, Fire District No. 1 is in the process of  
20 remodeling the Central Fire Station at Bouscaren and Sgt. Alfred;  
21

24 WHEREAS, the staff and personnel are presently located  
25 in temporary quarters at 291 Fremaux Avenue; and  
26

27 WHEREAS, the Central Fire Station is manned on a twenty  
28 four (24) hour basis, and must be used as living quarters; and  
29

30 WHEREAS, it would be more effective, efficient, and  
31 sanitary, for them to be housed in a trailer at this site; and  
32

33 WHEREAS, present zoning ordinances prohibits the  
34 temporary use of trailers for purposes other than offices; and  
35

36 WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission presently  
37 has under review, modifications to said zoning ordinances to  
38 provide for such expanded uses.

40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City  
41 Council that Section 2.902 of Appendix A-Zoning of the Code of  
42 Ordinances of the City of Slidell is hereby waived to permit the  
43 use of a trailer as temporary quarters for Fire District No. 1's  
44 Central Fire Station, at 291 Fremaux Avenue, during the periods of  
45 construction and renovations to its facilities at the corner of  
46 Bouscaren and Sgt. Alfred Drive.
