11 A resolution ordering and calling a special election to be
12 held in the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, on November
13 8, 1988, to authorize the incurring of debt and issuance of
14 bonds of said City; making application to the State Bond
15 Commission; and providing for other matters in connection
16 therewith.

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY the Slidell City Council, acting as the governing
20 authority of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"):
21

23 SECTION 1. That, subject to the approval of the State Bond Commis-
24 sion, and under the authority conferred by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitu-
25 tion of the State of Louisiana of 1974, Sub-Parts A and B, Part III, Chapter 4, and
26 Chapter 14A, Title 39 and the applicable provisions of Chapter 5, Chapter 6,
27 Chapter 6A and Chapter 6B, Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as
28 amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority supplemental thereto, a
29 special election be and the same is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City
30 on TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 1988, between the hours of six (6:00) o'clock a.m. and
31 eight (8:00) o'clock p.m., in compliance with the provisions of Section 541 of Title
32 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 (R.S. 18:541), and that at the said
33 election there shall be submitted to all registered voters qualified and entitled to
34 vote at the said election under the Constitution and laws of this State and the
35 Constitution of the United States, the following propositions, to-wit:

50 PROPOSITION NO. 1

52 Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"),
53 incur debt and issue general obligation bonds to the amount
54 of One Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,100,000),
55 to run twenty (20) years from date thereof, with interest at
56 a rate or rates not exceeding twelve per centum (12%) per
57 annum, for the purpose of acquiring and constructing
58 additions and improvements to the waterworks system of
59 said City along with the necessary sites and equipment
60 therefor, title to which shall be in the public, which bonds
61 will be general obligations of the City and payable from ad
62 valorem taxes to be levied and collected in the manner
63 provided by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the
64 State of Louisiana of 1974, and statutory authority
65 supplemental thereto?

67 PROPOSITION NO. 2

69 Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"),
70 incur debt and issue general obligation bonds to the amount
71 of One Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,900,000),
72 to run twenty (20) years from date thereof, with interest at
73 a rate or rates not exceeding twelve per centum (12%) per
74 annum, for the purpose of acquiring and constructing
75 additions and improvements to the sewer system of said
76 City along with the necessary sites and equipment therefor,
77 title to which shall be in the public, which bonds will be
78 general obligations of the City and payable from ad valorem
79 taxes to be levied and collected in the manner provided by
80 Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the State of
81 Louisiana of 1974, and statutory authority supplemental
82 thereto?

PROPOSITION NO. 3

Shall the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), incur debt and issue general obligation refunding bonds to the amount of Three Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$3,300,000), to run twenty (20) years from date thereof, with interest at a rate or rates not exceeding twelve per centum (12%) per annum, for the purpose of refunding, extending and unifying outstanding general obligation bonds of the City, which bonds will be general obligations of the City and payable from ad valorem taxes to be levied and collected in the manner provided by Article VI, Section 33 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, Chapter 14A of Title 39 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, and statutory authority supplemental thereto?

SECTION 2. That there shall be published in "The Slidell Sentry News," a newspaper of general circulation within the City, published in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, and being the official journal of this City Council, once a week for four consecutive weeks, with the first publication to be made not less than forty-five (45) days nor more than ninety (90) days prior to the date fixed for election, notice of said election, which notice shall be substantially in accordance with the Notice of Special Election annexed hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference the same as if it were set forth herein in full.

SECTION 3. That this City Council, acting as the governing authority of the City shall meet at its regular meeting place, the City Hall, 2055 Second Street, Slidell, Louisiana, on TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 22, 1988, at SIX-THIRTY (6:30) o'clock P.M., and shall then and there in open and public session proceed to examine and canvass the returns and declare the results of the said special election.

SECTION 4. That the polling places set forth in the aforesaid Notice of Special Election and situated within the corporate limits of the City be and the same are hereby designated as the polling places at which to hold the said election, and the Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners, respectively, will be those persons designated according to law.

SECTION 5. That the officers designated to serve as Commissioners-in-Charge and Commissioners pursuant to Section 4 hereof, or such substitutes therefor as may be selected and designated in compliance with Section 1287 of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 (R.S. 18:1287) shall hold the said special election as herein provided, shall make due returns of said election for

13 the meeting of the City Council on Tuesday, November 22, 1988, and that the
14 compensation of said officers be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum
15 prescribed by law. All registered voters in the City are entitled to vote at said
16 special election and voting machines shall be used thereat.

22 SECTION 6. That the Council Administrator, Clerk of the Council be
23 and he is hereby empowered, authorized and directed to arrange for and to furnish
24 to said election officers in ample time for the holding of said election the
25 necessary equipment, forms and other paraphernalia essential to the proper holding
26 of said election.

32 SECTION 7. That certified copies of this resolution shall be
33 forwarded to the Secretary of State, the Commissioner of Elections, the Clerk of
34 Court and Ex-Officio Parish Custodian of Voting Machines in and for the Parish of
35 St. Tammany, State of Louisiana, and the Registrar of Voters in and for said
36 Parish, as notification of the special election herein called in order that each may
37 prepare for said election and perform their respective functions as required by law.

45 SECTION 8. That application be and the same is hereby formally
46 made to the State Bond Commission for consent and authority to hold the aforesaid
47 special election as herein provided, and in the event said propositions carry, for
48 further consent and authority to sell, issue and deliver the bonds as provided for in
49 said propositions, and that a certified copy of this resolution shall be forwarded to
50 the State Bond Commission on behalf of this City Council together with a letter
51 requesting the prompt consideration and approval of this application.
