## **RESOLUTION R88-55**

A resolution requesting the Department of Transportation and Development establish a "No Truck Route" for State Highway 11 within the City of Slidell.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has increasing problems with truck traffic on State Highway 11 within the City; and

WHEREAS, hundreds of sand and gravel trucks travel this route daily; and

WHEREAS, many of these trucks appear to be overloaded; and

WHEREAS, portions of their cargos are continuously littering our streets; and

WHEREAS, the truck traffic is hampering regular traffic of the citizens of Slidell; and

WHEREAS, many citizens have sustained damage from said trucks; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has contacted its legislative delegates on this matter; and

WHEREAS, both Senator Hinton and Representative Scogin have recommended that the City request a "No Truck Route" for that portion on Slidell.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Slidell does hereby request that a "No Truck Route" be established for State Highway 11 within the City of Slidell, except for local deliveries.
