14 A resolution requesting an interchange at I-10 and
15 Fremaux Avenue for the City of Slidell.

17 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell and the Parish of St.
18 Tammany have experienced tremendous growth over the past ten (10)
19 years; and

23 WHEREAS, Fremaux Avenue has been widened to a four (4)
24 lane thoroughfare; and

28 WHEREAS, the existing Interstate Highway 10 system is
29 presently heavily burdened and it is anticipated that normal
30 growth of the population of the City of Slidell and the
31 surrounding area of St. Tammany Parish demand that new access
32 interchanges on I-10 be erected; and

36 WHEREAS, there is presently needed an interchange with
37 appropriate access at Fremaux Avenue and Interstate 10 and that
38 this interchange is presently under design and study by the
39 Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development, Division
40 of Highways; and

44 WHEREAS, the utilization of this interchange at
45 Interstate Highway 10 and Fremaux Avenue will alleviate much of
46 the present congestion of Louisiana 433 and Old Spanish Trail and
47 Gause Boulevard, and further would provide additional hurricane
48 evacuation for the area thereby prompting the peace, harmony, and
49 safety of the citizens of Slidell and St. Tammany Parish and those
50 visitors to the area.

54 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City
55 Council, in legal session convened, that the Slidell City Council
56 reminds the Department of Transportation and Development of it's
57 support for a new interchange at Fremaux Avenue at Interstate 10
58 for the City of Slidell and said interchange is considered to be a
59 primary goal for the future growth of the City.
