RESOLUTION R88-63

A resolution requesting the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development to design and properly mark left turning lanes from Bayou Liberty Road onto Palm Lake Road, and Bayou Liberty Road onto Canulette Road, Slidell, Louisiana.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Slidell City Council to eliminate conditions which impede traffic flow and create driving hazards in this City; and

WHEREAS, increased vehicular travel in the Slidell area at Bayou Liberty Road, Palm Lake Road and Canulette Road has created traffic congestion and hazardous conditions; and

WHEREAS, a serious problem exists at Bayou Liberty Road turning left onto Palm Lake Road, and Bayou Liberty Road turning left onto Canulette Road, in that vehicles desiring to exit onto these roads are causing traffic backups and possible safety hazards; and

WHEREAS, the designation and proper marking of left turning lanes at the above intersections would alleviate these problems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City

Council that it herewith requests the Louisiana Department of

Transportation and Development to designate and properly mark left

turning lanes from Bayou Liberty Road onto Palm Lake Road, and

Bayou Liberty Road onto Canulette Road, Slidell, St. Tammany

Parish, Louisiana.
