16 A resolution requesting the Louisiana Department of
17 Transportation and Development to design and properly mark left
18 turning lanes from Bayou Liberty Road onto Palm Lake Road, and
19 Bayou Liberty Road onto Canulette Road, Slidell, Louisiana.

21 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Slidell City Council to
22 eliminate conditions which impede traffic flow and create driving
23 hazards in this City; and

26 WHEREAS, increased vehicular travel in the Slidell area
27 at Bayou Liberty Road, Palm Lake Road and Canulette Road has
28 created traffic congestion and hazardous conditions; and

31 WHEREAS, a serious problem exists at Bayou Liberty Road
32 turning left onto Palm Lake Road, and Bayou Liberty Road turning
33 left onto Canulette Road, in that vehicles desiring to exit onto
34 these roads are causing traffic backups and possible safety
35 hazards; and

38 WHEREAS, the designation and proper marking of left
39 turning lanes at the above intersections would alleviate these
40 problems.

43 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City
44 Council that it herewith requests the Louisiana Department of
45 Transportation and Development to designate and properly mark left
46 turning lanes from Bayou Liberty Road onto Palm Lake Road, and
47 Bayou Liberty Road onto Canulette Road, Slidell, St. Tammany
48 Parish, Louisiana.
