15 A resolution recommending that the subject of chlorine
16 injection procedures be placed on the Council's Agenda until
17 resolved.

19 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has begun a program of
20
21 injecting chlorine into the City's water supply; and

22
23 WHEREAS, the City and officials have had hundreds of
24
25 complaints about said chlorine usage; and

26
27 WHEREAS, the City Engineer has stated that the City has
28
29 difficulties regulating the amount of chlorine in the water supply
30
31 because of several water well sites within the City; and


32
33 WHEREAS, a study of the City of Slidell's water supply
34
35 is presently underway to determine the exact chlorine content,
36
37 injection process; and

39 WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency and the
40
41 Department of Environmental Quality have not established any
42
43 regulations to date.

45 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council
46
47 that it does hereby order that this item be placed on the agenda
48
49 until the City's water system problems have been solved.

51 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor advise the
52
53 Council of Administrative recommendations as soon as possible.
