15 A resolution authorizing the expenditure of \$2,200 in

17 Tournament for girls sponsored by the Slidell Bantam Baseball

20 WHEREAS, the Slidell Bantam Baseball Association (SBBA)  
21  
22 and the City of Slidell has been chosen to host the National Pony  
23  
24 Slow Pitch Championship for girls; and

26 WHEREAS, said tournament will be held from August 9th  
27  
28 through 13th, 1989; and

30 WHEREAS, seventy-two (72) teams from all over the nation  
31  
32 will visit the City of Slidell; and

34 WHEREAS, parents, directors, umpires, and friends of the  
35  
36 tournament association and participants will be in our City; and

38 WHEREAS, said visitation shall have a substantial  
39  
40 economic impact for merchants and hotel/motels; and

42 WHEREAS, the SBBA is funded under the authorization of  
43  
44 the organized Sports Assistance Act of the City of Slidell  
45  
46 Ordinance No. 1203, dated September 11, 1979.

48 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City  
49  
50 Council that the City of Slidell does hereby authorize an  
51  
52 expenditure of \$2,200 in favor of the Slidell Bantam Baseball  
53  
54 Association for assistance with the National Pony Slow Pitch  
55  
56 Championship Tournament to be held in the City of Slidell from  
57  
58 August 9th through 13th, 1989. Said funds are to be provided from  
59  
60 the Cash Flow Capital Project Fund.
