15 A resolution requesting that a maximum of five hundred  
16 dollars (\$500) be appropriated for "No Solicitation" signs, and  
17 said signs be made available to residents of the City of Slidell  
18 upon request.

20 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has many solicitors  
21 especially in the evening hours; and  
22

23  
24 WHEREAS, the community has a large number of people who  
25 commute to work; and  
26

27  
28 WHEREAS, these residents must awake at an earlier than  
29 normal hour to prepare to depart for work; and

32 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell through Ordinance No. 2225  
33 limited the solicitation period from 8:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.; and  
34

35  
36 WHEREAS, groups which promote political and/or religious  
37 ideology have challenged our ordinance as a violation of the First  
38 Amendment of the United States Constitution; and  
39

40  
41 WHEREAS, some courts have upheld a solicitation period  
42 as late as 9:00 p.m. as reasonable.  
43

44  
45 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council  
46 that it does hereby request Administration to make available to all  
47 residents of the City of Slidell a sign stating "No Solicitation  
48 After 7:00 P.M." thereby assuring the privacy rights of its  
49 citizens. Said signs shall be free of charge, upon presentation  
50 of a City water bill, and expenditures of five hundred dollars  
51 (\$500) for said purpose is hereby requested.
