## RESOLUTION R89-21

A resolution rescinding and reenacting Resolution R89-18 which provides funding for the purchase of right-of-way for Airport Road.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City
Council that Resolution R89-18 is hereby rescinded and reenacted
as follows:

A resolution providing funding for the purchase of right-of-way for Airport Road.

WHEREAS, on September 16, 1986, by Ordinance No. 2012, the Slidell City Council approved an annexation agreement with Northshore Limited Partnership; and

WHEREAS, this agreement provided funding for right-of-way acquisition to widen Airport Road; and

WHEREAS, part of the right-of-way was to be purchased from Airport Road Properties; and

WHEREAS, funding for the purchase was appropriated in the \$3.8 million bond issue of 1986; and

WHEREAS, Airport Road Properties has not been paid for the right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, all remaining funds from the \$3.8 million bond issue have been re-budgeted for other projects; and

WHEREAS, there remains an unexpended balance from prior year and current year appropriations for capital equipment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City
Council that the City Administration is hereby authorized to
pay Airport Road Properties \$40,000 for the purchase of
right-of-way for Airport Road, the funding for which shall be
taken from the unexpended prior year and current year
appropriation for capital equipment. Said funding shall
consist of thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000) from
Utility Fund Equipment, and seven thousand dollars (\$7,000)
from Equipment (FY '89 allocation).
