WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is mandated (by Louisiana
Law Statute) to maintain fiscal solvency in the Utility Fund; and
WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is increasing the water
rates effective on July 5 billings to insure the Utility Fund is
solvent; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is treating the City Water system in compliance with Environmental Protection Agency's current and future directives on disinfecting municipal water systems to prevent intrusion of bacteria and other onerous matters; and

WHEREAS, all engineering reports advise we regulate, adapt and improve our present system to ensure uniform injection of appropriate chemicals to prevent smell, discoloration and taste.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council in legal session convened hereby recommends that the Administration develop an implementing plan towards solving the deficiencies noted above and set aside \$100,000 for this purpose from the recently passed \$1,100,000 Water Bond Issue.
