## RESOLUTION R89-24

A resolution acknowledging the City Administration's request for additional personnel.

WHEREAS, the City Administration has submitted a request for fourteen (14) additional full and part-time employees in their budget proposal for fiscal year 1989-90; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposal also contains requests for six (6) new Police Officers; and

WHEREAS, these additional staff positions would substantially increase the operating cost of the City; and

WHEREAS, City revenues are not increasing at the same rate of the requested expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the City budget as presented by the Administration does provide for capital expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the City is losing some of its bonding capacity if it allows expenses to increase more rapidly than its revenues; and

WHEREAS, the request for the additional personnel by the Administration was a bona fide effort to identify the needs of the City; and

WHEREAS, current City finances are insufficient to accomplish goals in the area of personnel; and

WHEREAS, the economic condition of the City may show improvements by mid-year.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council does hereby agree to reconsider the Administration's request for additional personnel in January, 1990.
