15 A resolution acknowledging the City Administration's  
16 request for additional personnel.

18 WHEREAS, the City Administration has submitted a request  
19 for fourteen (14) additional full and part-time employees in their  
20 budget proposal for fiscal year 1989-90; and

24 WHEREAS, the budget proposal also contains requests for  
25 six (6) new Police Officers; and  
26

27  
28 WHEREAS, these additional staff positions would  
29 substantially increase the operating cost of the City; and  
30

33 WHEREAS, City revenues are not increasing at the same  
34 rate of the requested expenditures; and  
35

36  
37 WHEREAS, the City budget as presented by the  
38 Administration does provide for capital expenditures; and

41 WHEREAS, the City is losing some of its bonding capacity if  
42 it allows expenses to increase more rapidly than its revenues; and

45 WHEREAS, the request for the additional personnel by the  
46 Administration was a bona fide effort to identify the needs of the  
47 City; and

50 WHEREAS, current City finances are insufficient to  
51 accomplish goals in the area of personnel; and  
52

53  
54 WHEREAS, the economic condition of the City may show  
55 improvements by mid-year.

58 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City  
59 Council does hereby agree to reconsider the Administration's  
60 request for additional personnel in January, 1990.
