A resolution setting forth the highway priorities for the City of Slidell.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has experienced tremendous growth over the past ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, major retail outlets are continuing to develop and locate in the Slidell area; and

WHEREAS, the existing roadways are heavily burdened to accommodate present traffic; and

WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana has recently completed a portion of the widening of Fremaux Avenue; and

WHEREAS, high traffic volumes inhibits the peace, harmony, and safety of the citizens of Slidell.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby set forth its major highway improvement priorities as follows:

- Widening of Highway 190 west from Highway 11 to Louisiana Highway 433.
- Construction of an interchange at I-10 and Fremaux 2. Avenue. In conjunction with the above, the construction of service roads connecting Highway 433, Highway 190, and Gause Boulevard.
- Widening of Highway 11 from Gause Boulevard to I-12. 3.
- Widening of Highway 433 from the Bayou Vincent bridge to Highway 11.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council anticipates that the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development will provide an immediate expansion of the roadways in and around the Manufacturer's Retail Outlet development at the intersection of I-10 and Highway 433.
