whereas, in the Trust Indenture dated March 6, 1979, of the St. Tammany Parish Public Trust Financing Authority (the "Authority"), it is required that the Slidell City Council of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, (the "City") as the governing authority of the City, one of the beneficiaries of the Authority, and the governing authority of the City of Covington, the other beneficiary of the Authority, consent to and concur in the issuance of revenue bonds by said Authority prior to the delivery of any such bonds to the purchaser thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Authority proposes to issue and deliver not exceeding \$40,000,000 Taxable Collateralized Mortgage
Refunding Bonds, Series 1989 (the "Bonds") for the purpose of refunding all of the Authority's outstanding Single Family
Mortgage Revenue Bonds (Multiple Originators and Servicers),
1979 Series A and to pay costs of issuance of the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the Bonds shall be solely the obligation of the Authority and not of the City, the City of Covington, or the state of Louisiana or any political subdivision thereof and shall not be secured by any funds of said City; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary and desirable that the Slidell City Council of the City consent to and concur in the proposed sale and issuance of the Bonds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City

SECTION 1. The Slidell City Council of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, does hereby consent to and concur in the sale, issuance and delivery of not exceeding \$40,000,000 of Taxable Collateralized Mortgage Refunding Bonds, Series 1989 (the "Bonds"), of the St. Tammany Parish Public Trust Financing Authority (the "Authority") for the purpose of refunding all of the Authority's outstanding Single Family Mortgage Revenue Bonds (Multiple Originators and Servicers), 1979 Series A and paying costs of the issuance of the Bonds.

SECTION 2. That the approval provided for in Section 1 hereof is given with the understanding that as soon as the net proceeds of the proposed financing become available, they will be invested at interest and two-thirds of such funds will be expended for the construction or acquisition of a new city hall for said city or transferred to the City for such purpose, or expended or transferred for such alternative purposes as may be approved by this city council.

SECTION 3. In accordance with the provisions of Article VIII of the Trust Indenture of March 6, 1979, creating the Authority, the following persons are hereby appointed, reappointed and hereby confirmed as Trustees of the Authority:

- (1) Ernest J. Cooper, Mayor, City of Covington for a six year term expiring March 6, 1991.
- (2) Lee Roy Jenkins, Councilman, City of Covington for a six year term expiring March 6, 1991.
- (3) Alvin D. Singletary, Councilman-at-Large of the City of Slidell for a six year term expiring March 6, 1991.
- (4) Salvatore "Sam" Caruso, Mayor, City of Slidell for a six year term expiring March 6, 1991.
- (5) Paul Spitzfaden, Mayor, City of Mandeville, serving a two year term expiring March 6, 1991.

 As provided by said Article VIII, the term of office of each of the aforesaid Trustees is terminated upon the resignation of or expiration of the term of municipal office, of such Trustee.

SECTION 4. That is accordance with Article VIII (3)(c) of the Trust Indenture, the employment of Foley & Judell of New Orleans, Louisiana, as bond counsel to the Authority in connection with the financing described in Section 1 hereof, is hereby approved.
