WHEREAS, said tax is the primary source of income for said library system; and

WHEREAS, said funds are for operation and maintenance purposes only; and

WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Library has been in existence since 1950; and

WHEREAS, said library provides important assistance for educational, cultural, and recreational purposes; and

WHEREAS, retired and relocated people appreciate a good library; and


WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Library has a reputation of high quality; and


WHEREAS, said library is an important community tool for study and research.
