RESOLUTION 89-52

A resolution endorsing Proposition One on October 7, 1989, creating a Transportation Trust Fund and other matters related thereto.

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of Louisiana have an opportunity to vote for the establishment of a Transportation

Trust Fund on October 7, 1989; and

WHEREAS, said trust fund would provide millions of dollars for improvements to roads, bridges and highways; and

WHEREAS, all of the current gasoline/motor fuel taxes (.16 \rlap/c per gallon) would be dedicated to the 1991-92 budget for said trust fund; and

WHEREAS, said amendment would increase the cost of gasoline by one cent (.01¢) per gallon; and

WHEREAS, Proposition One would repeal the three percent (3%) state sales tax on motor fuels, and would prohibit all future sales taxes on gasoline.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City
Council does hereby support the provisions of Proposition One, and
encourages the citizens of the City of Slidell to vote for said
proposition on October 7, 1989.
