WHEREAS, Ralph Smith filed a grievance with the Municipal Police Civil Service Board alleging non-compliance with the Fair Labor Standards Act by the Slidell Police Department; and

WHEREAS, due to Mr. Smith's complaint, the Police
Department changed its method of computing compensatory time;
and

WHEREAS, if Mr. Smith had filed his complaint in federal court rather than with the Civil Service Board, the City may have been responsible for paying his attorney's fees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City
Council that the Council does hereby authorize payment to
Madeleine Slaughter, Mr. Smith's attorney, in the amount of
\$788.00 as attorney's fees for representing Mr. Smith before the
Municipal Police Civil Service Board in the previously
referenced matter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this action by the Slidell City Council is not intended to be a precedent for payment of legal services for similar cases in the future.
