16 emergency repairs to the Lee Street Pump Station.

18 WHEREAS, the No. 1 pump at the Lee Street Drainage Pump
19 Station was severely damaged on February 21; and

22 WHEREAS, it is an emergency situation and time does not
23 provide for the solicitation of bids; and

26 WHEREAS, an auxiliary pump will have to be rented during
27 the time that repairs are being made; and

30 WHEREAS, the Engineering Department is recommending that
31 repairs be made to pump No. 2 simultaneously in an effort to
32 minimize costs; and

35 WHEREAS, the best estimates on said repairs are between
36 twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) and fifty thousand
37 dollars (\$50,000.00).

42 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council
43 that an emergency situation does hereby exist at the Lee Street
44 Pump Station.


