11 **RESOLUTION R90-20**

12  
13 A resolution requesting the State of Louisiana  
14 Department of Transportation and Development to look into the  
15 feasibility of adding an additional exit ramp north of current  
16 Gause Boulevard off I-10, so as to help alleviate the traffic  
17 congestion at the intersection of Gause Boulevard and I-10.

18  
19 WHEREAS, the area in the vicinity of I-10 and Gause  
20 Boulevard (Louisiana Highway 190 East) has experienced an increase  
21 in growth and commercial development in the recent past; and

22  
23 WHEREAS, this commercialization has increased traffic at  
24 said intersection in excess of fifty thousand (50,000) vehicles  
25 per day; and

26  
27 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Slidell City Council to  
28 provide for the safety of the citizens and motorist in the City of  
29 Slidell; and

31 WHEREAS, information provided by engineers indicates  
32 that an additional exit ramp north of Gause Boulevard off I-10  
33 would assist in relieving congestion and traffic hazards at said  
34 intersection.

35  
36 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council  
37 that it herewith request that the State of Louisiana Department of  
38 Transportation and Development look into the feasibility of  
39 adding an additional exit ramp north of current Gause Boulevard  
40 off I-10, so as to help alleviate the traffic congestion at the  
41 intersection of Gause Boulevard and I-10.

43 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the adoption of this  
44 Resolution does not change the Slidell City Council's position to  
45 urge the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development to  
46 fully upgrade the intersections of Gause Boulevard and I-10, and  
47 I-10 and Shortcut Highway.
