RESOLUTION R90-28

A resolution requesting that the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury deny the request for rezoning and/or a conditional use permit for property owned by Louis Ybos D.D.S. on Robert Boulevard.

WHEREAS, Mr. Louis Ybos D.D.S. has petitioned the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury for rezoning and/or a conditional use permit for 0.253 acres of land on Robert Boulevard from C-1 Neighborhood Commercial to C-2 Highway Commercial; and

WHEREAS, said zoning change and/or requested conditional use would be compatible with the City of Slidell's C-4 Highway Commercial classification; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has historically opposed Highway Commercial zoning on Robert Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the property in question is purported to be under consideration for use as an animal hospital and kennel; and

WHEREAS, animal hospitals are not permitted under the City's C-2 zoning classification; and

WHEREAS, said property abuts residential property on its rear property boundary.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City
Council does hereby oppose the rezoning and requested conditional
use of property owned by Louis Ybos D.D.S. on the south side of
Robert Boulevard three blocks east of the St. Tammany Parish
Library and directly opposite the First Christian Church from
Parish C-1 Neighborhood Commercial to Parish C-2 Highway
Commercial to be used as an animal hospital and kennel.
