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20 WHEREAS, Section 131 of Title 2 of the Louisiana Revised
21 Statutes of 1950 provides that cities, towns, parishes, and other
22 political subdivisions of this State may separately or jointly
23 acquire, establish, construct, expand, own, lease, control, equip,
24 improve, maintain, operate, regulate, and police airports and
25 landing fields for the use of aircraft; and
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28 WHEREAS, the State of Louisiana, Department of
29 Transportation and Development, Division of Aviation (formerly the
30 LA DOTD-OAPT) is charged by Section 6 of Title 2 of the Louisiana
31 Revised Statutes of 1950 with the responsibility for the
32 development of aviation facilities within the State to foster air
33 commerce and to safeguard the interests of those engaged in all
34 phases of the aviation industry and of the general public; and
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37 WHEREAS, in conjunction with the comprehensive aviation
38 development program of the LA DOTD, Division of Aviation and the
39 Federal Aviation Administration, an Airport Master Plan was
40 completed in 1984 which outlines the specific development of the
41 Slidell Municipal Airport; and
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44 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is desirous of implementing
45 a portion of the Airport Master Plan recommendations which provide
46 for critically needed improvements to substantially improve the
47 safety and usability of the Airport, but does not have sufficient
48 funds of its own to finance the matching funds required for

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52 WHEREAS, the LA DOTD, Division of Aviation is authorized
53 by the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950 to expend funds for the
54 construction of enlargement of airports for the safety and

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11 SECTION 1. That the City of Slidell does hereby formally
12 request that the LA DOTD, Division of Aviation provide funds
13 which amount to ten percent (10%) of the total funds required
14 to complete the airport improvements described as extension
15 of runway to five thousand feet (5000'); relocate access
16 road; aircraft parking apron expansion; runway lighting for
17 runway extension and relocate VASI; strengthen runway,
18 taxiway and aprons; extend taxiway to five thousand feet
19 (5000'); install perimeter security fence; stub taxiway and
20 partial parallel taxiway for future T-hanger area; cleaning
21 and land acquisition for runway 17; and funding for
22 engineering services related to project's implementation at
23 the Slidell Municipal Airport. The City of Slidell does
24 hereby appoint and authorize the LA DOTD, Division of
25 Aviation to act as agent for the City of Slidell for the
26 following purposes:

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31 SECTION 2. That the said LA DOTD, Division of Aviation be
32 and is hereby assured that all necessary servitudes, rights-
33 of-way, rights of ingress and egress and means thereof will
34 be furnished by the City of Slidell and the titles thereto
35 will be valid and indefeasible, and that the City of Slidell
36 and the titles thereto will be valid and indefeasible, and
37 that the City of Slidell will assume ownership, financial
38 reporting and complete responsibility for the maintenance and
39 upkeep of the airport after completion of said improvements.
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

52 employees, harmless from any liability or claim for damages
53 arising out of the project, including death or injuries to
54 third parties including, but not limited to, liability or

56 Division of Aviation, its officers, agents or employees, and
57 expressly agrees to defend any suit of any nature brought
58 against the LA DOTD, Division of Aviation as a result of this

17 the FAA and the Clerk is hereby authorized to attest said
18 execution.
