

30 of this facility poses a potential community hazard which far
31 outweighs any potential financial gains presented by the company
32 operations.



37 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City
38 Council, in legal session convened, that it does hereby request
39 the following:

43 1. The owners of this facility (while recognizing the
44 company's legal right to continue their construction)
45 are hereby requested to stop progress of constructing
46 this plant; and

51 2. That said company is encouraged to seek alternative sites
52 in St. Tammany Parish which are isolated to the point that
53 safety and health hazards are not a potential risk to any
54 of our citizens; and

59 3. Finally, that the State Department of Environmental
60 Quality and the Federal Department of Environmental
61 Protection Agency so recognize our opposition to this
62 project being located within our community that they are
63 requested to deny any and all such permits for continued
64 construction of this plant in our community.
