15 A resolution requesting funding for a review of the City
16 of Slidell's pay plans.
17

18 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell had adopted a new pay plan
19 for its non-police municipal employees effective July 1, 1990; and
20

21 WHEREAS, the City proposes to adopt a new pay plan for its
22 municipal police employees to become effective July 1, 1991; and
23

24 WHEREAS, the municipal Police Department has requested
25 that a third party consultant be engaged to assist with this
26 undertaking; and
27

28 WHEREAS, said review of the municipal Police Department's
29 pay plan would include salary surveys, evaluation forms, job
30 descriptions, and suggested classification of employees; and
31

32 WHEREAS, it would be advantageous to have an overview of
33 the recently adopted municipal employee pay plan to coincide with
34 the police pay plan; and
35

36 WHEREAS, said overview would include an independent
37 salary survey, and a review of job classifications.
38

39 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City
40 Council does hereby approve of the employment of a personnel
41 consultant to review the City's municipal and police pay plans.
42

43 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that five thousand dollars
44 (\$5,000.00) are hereby appropriated from the equipment and project
45 reserve fund for the municipal pay plan review.
46

47 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the current Police
48 Department budget allocations in an amount of eight thousand
49 dollars (\$8,000.00) are hereby authorized as funding for the
50 herein described services.
