15 A resolution assuring that thirty-one thousand four
16 hundred eighty-one dollars (\$31,481.00) will be available in the
17 City of Slidell's 1991-92 budget to complete grant requirements
18 from the Office of State Parks.

20 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has submitted a grant
21 application to the Office of State Parks, Division of Outdoor
22 Recreation; and

25 WHEREAS, the City is proposing to improve John Slidell
26 Park by enhancing its roadway, preparation of a general purpose
27 playing field, development of picnic areas, and the construction
28 of a fitness and nature trail; and


32 WHEREAS, conditions of the grant require a fifty percent
33 (50%) match by the local grantee; and

36 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell proposes to include fifteen
37 thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) in cash, and sixteen thousand four
38 hundred eighty-one dollars (\$16,481.00) of in-kind service to
39 fulfill its fifty percent (50%) match requirement.

43 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City
44 Council does hereby assure the funding of fifteen thousand dollars
45 (\$15,000.00) in cash, and sixteen thousand four hundred eighty-one
46 dollars (\$16,841.00) of in-kind services for the budget year
47 beginning July 1, 1991.

50 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these funds shall be used as
51 the fifty percent (50%) match requirement to secure a grant for
52 the herein stated purposes from the Office of State Parks,
53 Division of Outdoor Recreation.
