15 A resolution granting and approving a three percent (3%)
16 cost-of-living increase and appropriating funds for the
17 implementation of revisions to the City employees pay plans.

19 WHEREAS, the City Council has established two hundred
20 thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) for the implementation of revisions
21 to the City employees pay plans by joint resolution of the Slidell
22 City Council and the Mayor; and

26 WHEREAS, Ernest J. Langenhennig and Associates has
27 completed a salary survey of City employees and has developed a
28 pay plan for the municipal police employees and a recommendation
29 for a companion pay plan for municipal civil service employees;

35 WHEREAS, the Municipal Police Civil Service Board has
36 approved said plan; and

40 WHEREAS, said proposal recommends a three percent (3%)
41 cost-of-living increase for all employees as part of the
42 implementation procedure; and

46 WHEREAS, said plan has long term benefits to the City of
47 Slidell.

51 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council
52 that it does hereby grant and approve the following salary and
53 employee benefit allocations:

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that allocations from the Capital

30 Outlay Fund have provisions wherein funds can be appropriated by a

32 joint resolution of the City Council and Mayor, and that this

34 Council does also request Mayor Salvatore A. Caruso to open the

36 1991-92 budget for the purpose of having the Council adopt
37
38 amendments to the budget to reflect the action of this resolution.

41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Council expresses its
42
43 intention for the herein described cost-of-living adjustment to be
44
45 effective July 1, 1991, and does hereby request that it be
46
47 implemented accordingly.



51 hereby have two million seven hundred thousand dollars

53 (\$2,700,000.00) presently on deposit as proceeds from the St.

55 Tammany Public Trust Financing Authority at an interest rate of

57 six percent (6%) per year, and does hereby pledge all interest

59 income therefrom to replace the capital funds used to implement

61 the cost-of-living adjustment for 1991-92.

63 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the General-Sales Tax

65 Capital Allocation for fiscal year 1991-92 shall be one million

67 four hundred thirty-four thousand, seven hundred fifty-five

69 dollars (\$1,434,755.00) and the Utility Fund Capital Allocation

71 shall be three hundred forty-five thousand, nine hundred nine

73 dollars (\$345,909.00) for a total City Capital Allocation of


