WHEREAS, the Slidell Greater Chamber of Commerce has initiated a program entitled "Leadership Slidell"; and

WHEREAS, twenty-two (22) members completed and graduated from said program on June 5, 1991; and

WHEREAS, Leadership Slidell participants have developed pertinent information about the City of Slidell and have made the following recommendations:

- 1) The formation of a Slidell Metropolitan Planning Commission to guide the City and outlying suburban areas of the Parish in the development as well as the maintenance of a cohesive community identity. Said commission shall consist of representatives of the creative community including but not limited to architects, artists, designers, urban planners, homeowners, and zoning and permit personnel, and shall act in an advisory capacity to the Slidell City Council and the Parish.
- 2) The Mayor, City Council, and/or local Parish representatives should call a series of public meetings with the community at large to determine a long range plan for the image of the area, with the community receiving bi-annual updates on the progress towards the realization of identified goals with the Slidell Metropolitan Planning Commission assuming the responsibilities of informing the public.
- Area of the City of Slidell as current improvements have been enthusiastically accepted by the citizens of Slidell and should remain a priority for the City.
