A resolution expressing an intent to employ a Grants Administrator.

WHEREAS, federal and state governmental agencies have numerous grant funds available for municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has no individual assigned to seek out grants on a permanent basis; and

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell could benefit greatly from having a full time Grants Administrator.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council does hereby request the City Administration to investigate and recommend the employment of a qualified Grants Administrator to seek grants for the City of Slidell, on a six (6) month contract basis starting January 1, 1992, not to exceed fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00), with funding provided from the supplemental budget for the 1991-92 fiscal year.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Administration is hereby requested to provide the Council with a specific contract for such an Administrator including the detailing of all costs involved.
