**RESOLUTION R91-78**

A resolution dedicating a portion of the 20.8 acres of  
land located on Camp Villere Road for the use as a Slidell  
Community College Campus, with the concurrence of the East St.  
Tammany Events Center Commission.

WHEREAS, the City of Slidell is the owner of 20.8 acres  
of land located on Camp Villere Road; and

WHEREAS, said property had previously been dedicated for  
use as the East St. Tammany Events Center Commission; and

WHEREAS, the East St. Tammany Events Center Commission  
may not have a need for the entire parcel of said property; and


WHEREAS, Delgado College and the President Elect of the  
Board of Trustees for State Colleges and Universities have  
expressed an interest in a portion of said land; and


WHEREAS, the Community College could provide facilities  
through mutual agreements with Southeastern, UNO, and other  
universities in Louisiana to provide junior, senior, and  
graduate courses; and

WHEREAS, said President Elect of the Board of Trustees  
for State Colleges and Universities has indicated that they  
could be prepared to invest in substantial improvements in the  
form of buildings to house a Community College.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City  
Council does hereby express its intent, with the concurrence of  
the East St. Tammany Events Center Commission, to lease a portion  
of the 20.8 acres of land located on Camp Villere Road to the  
Board of Trustees for State Colleges and Universities to be used  
as a Slidell Community College Campus and the remaining land to be  
used for East St. Tammany Events Center.
