

26 drugs, and drug or alcohol abuse.

 - 28 2. The right to homes and neighborhoods free of illegal
29 drugs, and drug or alcohol abuse.

 - 31 3. The right to schools and colleges free of illegal drugs,
32 and drug or alcohol abuse.
33
 - 34 4. The right to streets and highways free of drivers who
35 are under the influence of alcohol or other drugs.

 - 37 5. The right to beaches, parks, and other recreational
38 settings which are free of illegal drugs, and drug or
39 alcohol abuse.

 - 41 6. The right to communities that support healthy, drug and
42 alcohol-free lifestyles.
