- The right to homes and neighborhoods free of illegal 2. drugs, and drug or alcohol abuse.
- The right to schools and colleges free of illegal drugs, 3. and drug or alcohol abuse.
- 4. The right to streets and highways free of drivers who are under the influence of alcohol or other drugs.
- The right to beaches, parks, and other recreational 5. settings which are free of illegal drugs, and drug or alcohol abuse.
- The right to communities that support healthy, drug and 6. alcohol-free lifestyles.
