WHEREAS, said appropriation will be made in the 1992-93
budget; and


WHEREAS, the Slidell Police Department and the St.

construction of said project; and


WHEREAS, the City Administration has suggested that one

proceeds to provide for said interim funding.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City
