WHEREAS, the City of Slidell makes contributions and/or payments to agencies and organizations to perform and assist the City with various activities; and



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council does hereby request agencies and organizations receiving five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) or more of City funds per year to provide the Slidell City Council with a quarterly Treasurer's report and a written report of its activities, and to appear before the City Council on an annual basis to make an oral report thereon in the month of January or February each year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any organizations whose annual appropriations is established by ordinance is hereby exempt from the herein requirement.
