RESOLUTION R92-48

A resolution ordering and calling a special election to be held in the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana, on the adoption of a certain ordinance regarding the construction of a new city hall, and making application to the State Bond Commission in connection therewith and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council, acting as the governing authority of the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana:

SECTION I. That, subject to the approval of the State Bond Commission and under the authority conferred by Article VI, Section 5 and 22 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, the applicable provisions of Chapters 5, 6-A, and 6-B of Title 18 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, as amended, and other constitutional and statutory authority, a special election to be and the same is hereby called and ordered to be held in the City of Slidell, State of Louisiana (the "City"), on Tuesday, November 3, 1992, between the hours of six o'clock (6:00) a.m., and eight o'clock (8:00) p.m., in compliance with the provision of La. R.S. 18:541, and that at the said election there shall be submitted to all registered voters qualified and entitled to vote at the said election under the Constitution and Laws of this State and the Constitution of the United States, the following proposition, to-wit:

A new city hall shall be built for the City of Slidell, Louisiana.

SECTION II. That there shall be published in "The Slidell Sentry-News", a daily newspaper of general circulation within the City, published in the City of Slidell, Louisiana, and being the official journal of this City, once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks, with the first publication to be made not less than forty-five (45) days nor more than ninety (90) days prior to the date fixed for election, notice of said election, which notice shall be substantially in accordance with the Notice of Special Election annexed hereto as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference the same as if it were set forth herein in full.

25 designated according to law.



27 **SECTION V.** That the officers designated to serve as Commissioners-in-

29 Charge and Commissioners pursuant to Section IV hereof, or such substitutes

31 therefore as may be selected and designated in compliance with Louisiana Revised

33 Statutes 18:1287 shall hold the said special election as herein provided, and shall

35 make due returns of said election for the meeting of the City Council to be held on

37 November 10, 1992. All registered voters in the City are entitled to vote at said

41 **SECTION VI.** That the Clerk of the Council be and is hereby empowered,


