8 **RESOLUTION R92-54**

10 A resolution requesting joint participation by the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury  
11 and the City of Slidell for infrastructure improvements to accommodate a new development at  
12 North Shore Village where the City of Slidell and Parish of St. Tammany are participating in an  
13 Inter-Governmental Agreement for sharing of sales tax revenues.  
14

15 WHEREAS, the St. Tammany Parish Police Jury and the City of Slidell entered into  
16 an Inter-Governmental Agreement to amicably resolve sales tax jurisdictional disagreements for  
17 the benefit of all of the residents of our community; and  
18

19 WHEREAS, this Agreement provided for the equal sharing of sales tax revenues  
20 from the Manufacturer's Retail Outlet (MRO) after the reimbursement to the City of Slidell for the  
21 necessary infrastructure improvement expenses; and  
22

23 WHEREAS, as part of the Agreement the Parish also participated in the revenues  
24 from the North Shore Village development under the same formula for revenue participation as  
25 the MRO project; and

27 WHEREAS, these developments are now providing the City of Slidell and St.  
28 Tammany Parish Police Jury approximately nine hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$930,000.00)  
29 in revenues annually with an even greater potential for the future; and


31 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell wishes to continue to cooperate with the St.  
32 Tammany Parish Police Jury to provide facilities and services for the addition of another business  
33 and increased customers access at the North Shore Village development to enhance its revenue  
34 potential; and

36 WHEREAS, the City of Slidell has proposed three hundred sixty-seven thousand  
37 dollars (\$367,000.00) additional improvements for North Shore Boulevard to provide for better and  
38 safer access for the increased retail activity and providing the needed infrastructure services for  
39 the new retail development.

41 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council and the St.  
42 Tammany Parish Police Jury agree to participate by allowing for the reimbursement of  
43 improvement expenses prior to the implementation of the formula for proceeds distribution on  
44 new facilities and does hereby further recommend that this be the standard for all municipalities  
45 within St. Tammany Parish.
