RESOLUTION R93-01

A resolution identifying drainage as a serious and urgent problem within the City of Slidell and calling for certain remedial action.

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council recognizes that flooding is a serious and urgent problem and there is a need for improved drainage; and

WHEREAS, within the last sixty (60) days a marked increase in flooding has been documented and certain rain waters appear to be backing up instead of draining; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council has budgeted more than seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000.00) in the 1992-93 budget designated for drainage improvements; and

WHEREAS, St. Tammany Parish has recently obtained a designation for inclusion in the Federal Urban Flood System Program; and

WHEREAS, said program authorizes approximately eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000.00) in monies to the Corp of Engineer to review flooding and flood control measures for St. Tammany Parish; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Flood System is a long-range program with possible additional funding at the conclusion of the Corp of Engineer's review thereto; and

WHEREAS, this program may take several years to be completed; and

WHEREAS, the City needs professional expertise to evaluate and make corrective recommendations for drainage and flood control improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council desires to hire a professional firm to develop a plan for immediate and long-term solutions to our City's flooding problems; and

WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council desires to immediately implement recommendations; and


WHEREAS, drainage improvements would be realized parish wide.
