6 A resolution authorizing the transfer of surplus appropriations to provide for certain
7 drainage work, hepatitis vaccinations, and sludge lagoon demolition.
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9 WHEREAS, the Slidell City Council appropriated certain district funds for paving
10 improvements in 1991 identified in Account No. 20910-91014; and
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12 WHEREAS, hepatitis shots are recommended for the police department, and sewer
13 and water treatment personnel; and
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15 WHEREAS, additional funds are necessary to complete the sludge lagoon
16 demolition project; and
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18 WHEREAS, the sludge lagoon demolition project has a remaining balance of four
19 thousand seven hundred sixty-two dollars (\$4,762.00) with a total of approximately twenty
20 thousand dollars (\$20,000.00) necessary to complete the project.
