

RESOLUTION R93-28

A resolution opposing the granting of any permit for a riverboat gambling casino in St. Tammany Parish.

WHEREAS, certain applications may have been submitted to the Riverboat Gaming Commission and Governor Edwin Edwards requesting permission to locate a riverboat gambling casino on the north shore of Lake Pontchartrain; and

WHEREAS, in our opinion, the citizens of Slidell are overwhelming against such activities in this community; and

WHEREAS, it is felt that gambling activities would take away from present family and recreational activities; and


WHEREAS, people have been migrating to St. Tammany Parish to enjoy the quality of life that exist in this area; and

WHEREAS, gambling activities would infringe thereon; and

WHEREAS, certain people that desire to partake in gambling activities have ample opportunities on the Mississippi Gulf Coast and in the City of New Orleans.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Slidell City Council that it does hereby express stringent objections to the granting of any gambling permits within St. Tammany Parish.
