9 A resolution referencing the annexation of the Wyndemere Subdivision.

10  
11 WHEREAS, the St. James Investment Corporation approached the City of  
12 Slidell for annexation of the Wyndemere Subdivision into the City of Slidell; and

13  
14  
15 WHEREAS, said subdivision was approved by the City's Planning and  
16 Zoning Commission and was ready for City Council approval; and

18  
19 WHEREAS, numerous meetings were conducted with the developer by city  
20 officials and all provisions of the developer's application and plans were jointly agreed to  
21 by the City and the developer; and

25 WHEREAS, the developer has elected to withdraw his request for  
26 annexation in favor of building the development under the more lax guidelines of St.  
27 Tammany Parish.

31 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Slidell City Council does  
32 hereby declare that the Wyndemere Subdivision shall only be annexed into the City of  
33 Slidell provided all city code requirements, and negotiated requirements are met since the  
34 subdivision requirements of the Parish are to be built substandard as compared with  
35 those of the City of Slidell.

41 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Slidell does hereby oppose  
42 and formally object to the construction of a community sewer treatment plant in the  
43 proposed Wyndemere Subdivision since the City of Slidell has a tertiary treatment plant  
44 that would be available with annexation that has met the more stringent EPA standards.

49 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the City of Slidell requests the  
50 Environmental Protection Agency to stop and prohibit the construction of a community  
51 treatment plant for the Wyndemere Subdivision until a public hearing can be held on this  
52 matter to adequately assess its impact on the surrounding community and an  
53 environmental impact statement has been properly prepared showing the effects of  
54 wastewater run-off from the treatment plant that this facility will have upon the Lake  
55 Pontchartrain Drainage Basin Area.
